



European Prize for Young Scholars in Law, Politics and Social Sciences

The Prize is instituted by the scientific journal *Democrazia e Sicurezza - Democracy and Security Review*, by the Multimedia Laboratory of Law Comparison of the Department of Political Studies, Roma Tre University and in collaboration with the European Documentation Centre DiSciPol Roma Tre.

The Prize will be awarded to the author of the best paper, chosen according to the procedures specified in the attached Regulations, **provided that he/she has not passed the 35th year of age at the expiry date indicated below.**

Each scholar, having at least a master's degree (or an equivalent qualification obtained in Italy or abroad) will have to write in Italian, English, French or Spanish – and submit a paper about Italian, Foreign, Comparative, European or International Law, dealing with one of these areas:

1. Security and migrations in European legal space
2. Protecting fundamental rights in multicultural societies

The awarded paper will be published on the journal and the author will receive a monetary contribution for a mission of at least one month in Italy or abroad, at Universities, Research or High Culture Centers and Public Institutions, in order to study in deep the object of the awarded paper: the winner will have to document incurred expenses and will receive up to 2,000 Euros.

At the end of the mission, the winner will also be able to submit to the Prize organizers a monograph dealing with the theme of his/her research: if the monograph is deemed worthy of publication, it will be insert in a book series edited by Roma TrE-Press.

Interested scholars have to submit their application – filling the attached form – and their paper (in *.doc, *.docx format) **not later than March 31st, 2019**, to

the certified email address labmulticomp@ateneo.uniroma3.it, with the subject: «Premio Europeo 2018-2019».

The Judging Commission will be composed of national and international scholars and experts: its members will be announced – as required by the Regulations – after the expiry date already indicated.

Regulations

1. The Prize, for young scholars in Law, Politics and Social Sciences, is instituted by the scientific journal *Democrazia e Sicurezza - Democracy and Security Review*, by the Multimedia Laboratory of Law Comparison of the Department of Political Studies, Roma Tre University and in collaboration with the European Documentation Centre DiSciPol Roma Tre.
2. The Prize aims to encourage and increase scientific research on the topics identified by *Democrazia e Sicurezza - Democracy and Security Review*, online scientific journal edited by Roma Tre University.
3. The winner of the Prize will obtain the publication of his/her paper in the journal and also a monetary contribution for a mission of at least one month in Italy or abroad, at Universities, Research or High Culture Centers and Public Institutions, in order to study in deep the object of the awarded paper. That contribution to incurred and documented expenses will cover up to 2,000 Euros.
4. Each scholar, having at least a master's degree (or an equivalent qualification obtained in Italy or abroad) will be able to participate in the Prize, writing – in Italian, English, French or Spanish – and submitting a paper about Italian, Foreign, Comparative, European or International Law. At the expiry date indicate in the announcement, the age of the author of the awarded paper will not have to pass the 35th year.
5. The announcement of the Prize is published on the website of the journal, on the website of Roma Tre University and, if it is possible, on other websites of national and international relevance, at least three months before the expiry date.
6. The Judging Commission will be composed of national and international scholars and experts drawn by lot among the members of the Scientific Committee of the journal and the Presidents of national and international scientific associations and societies.
7. The Commission will choose the winner among the authors of the papers that will have successfully passed the Peer Review procedure (*double blind review*).
8. In addition to the winner, each author that will successfully pass Peer Review procedure will be entitled to have his/her paper published in the journal.

9. The Commission will be established within twenty days from the expiry date indicated in the announcement; the members of the Commission will be announced on the website of the journal.
10. The application forms and the papers can be submitted only through certified email, to the address labmulticomp@ateneo.uniroma3.it.
